

# Inventor's Summer Camp Scholarship 2020 Applicant Registration

The Edison & Ford Winter Estates will be offering a limited number of scholarships to students for the 2020 summer camp programs.

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must demonstrate an interest in history, natural science, horticulture, culture, arts or the environment. Their interest should be relevant to the program for which they are applying. The applicant must have a financial need for the scholarship. A completed registration form, a letter of recommendation from a teacher, school official, or mentor along with a one-page essay must be submitted to be considered for a scholarship. Any missing items will disqualify the applicant.

Scholarship applications are due to the Edison & Ford Winter Estates by April 17, 2020, any applications received after this date will not qualify for the scholarships.

Scholarships are for the camp only.

Applicants will be notified of scholarship awards by letter.

### **Application Instructions:**

- 1) A parent or guardian should complete the scholarship application registration form. Please use a separate registration form for each applicant.
- 2) Attach a one-page essay. The essay should be written by the student and not exceed 2000 words.

The essay should address the following criteria:

- i) Why you would like to attend the Inventor's Summer Camp
- ii) How your interests relate to the selected class
- iii) How the scholarship would benefit you
- 3) Attach a letter of recommendation from teacher, school official, or mentor (administrator or guidance counselor).

The letter must address the following criteria:

- i) Reason for recommending student to the program
- ii) Description of student's interest in science
- iii) How the program would benefit the student
- 4) Submit Scholarship Application Registration Form along with letter of recommendation to:
